KENYA - GERMANY TRADE BRIEF

Kenya and Germany boast a robust trade relationship, fostering mutual economic benefits through a burgeoning exchange of goods and services. This thriving bilateral trade has showcased a diverse range of Kenyan products penetrating the German market.

In 2022, Kenya's exports to Germany reached a value of USD 135.4 million, with top products including coffee (37.4%), cut flowers and buds (19.4%), other nuts, fresh or dried (8.5%), live plants and cuttings (8.5%), and dried fruits like dates, pineapples, avocados, mangoes, and mangosteens (8.0%).

These top five products accounted for 79.1% of total exports, signaling the importance of diversifying products in the German market.

This trade brief aims to explore the multifaceted aspects of this bilateral trade, revealing key sectors and market trends of the Kenya-Germany trade.
