KENYA – SOUTH AFRICA TRADE BRIEF

Both Kenya and South Africa play pivotal roles in the African economy, engaging in bilateral trade across various sectors. Notably, the products with the greatest export potential from Kenya to South Africa include:

- Black tea, packings >3kg, with a customs tariff of MFN at 2.23%
- Disodium carbonate with a customs tariff of MFN at 5.50% and
- Cut roses and buds, fresh, with a customs tariff of MFN at 20%

This trade brief delves into the intricacies of bilateral trade, shedding light on key sectors and market trends within Kenya-South Africa trade relations.
