The edible oils segment covers any oil extracted from plants, animals and nuts for cooking and food preparation.

Edible oils, animal or vegetable fats, are fatty liquids extracted from vegetables and animal tissues. While palm oil is the most common edible oil, other edible oil products include sunflower, rapeseed (canola), soybean, olive, castor, copra, avocado oil, corn oil, and coconut oil
